Andrea helps the residents in any way she can, whether that's holding a baby while they rest, bringing a meal during her shift, cleaning, or just sitting and chatting with them. Star of the North Maternity Home would like to welcome Kim Fagan to our team! Kim is the new Program Manager for our new location on the Iron Range. Born and raised in Hibbing, Kim came back to retire with family. She's a mom of two amazing children, and loves to travel. Her background includes being a foster mother, running a day care that specializes in infant and toddler care, and 12 years working in occupational therapy. Her biggest passion has also been working with non profit organizations working as a financial counselor, and being a HUD Certified Housing counselor helping the homeless find housing.

Kim's story is one of a kind and she loves to tell it. Semi-retired, Kim was walking down the street one day and came across a sign that said "Pray to End Abortion". She says, "something just came over me, and I stopped dead in my tracks! Then, I heard this voice, and it was loud in my head telling me that I can't just pray to end abortion, that I would have to work for it". She says the voice was so loud, she instantly called her priest, Father Daniel, to tell him her experience. Coincidentally, he had just heard talk of a possible maternity home starting in Hibbing. Father Daniel connected Kim with Star of the North, and then her journey began.

SON Iron Range is like our Duluth location, with a twist. We offer four, two bedroom apartments, and are adding two more. It's ideal for Moms that have infants, or wanting to reunite with their other children or families. It's a unique because we can house up to 10 moms, with 24/7 staff.

She currently has a team of 6 part time staff members, and 16 volunteers that have been helping her open our new location. Kim can't say enough good about her staff and volunteers, "They come from a variety of backgrounds, offer a lot of different opportunities to teach, like taking over cooking on Mondays and helping with meal planning." In addition, we have a Bible study instructor, ECFE connections, life coach and a travel blogger who shares her worldly experiences with our moms in an effort to broaden their perspectives.

She says, "We're thrilled to empower moms towards independence and success with their lives."
